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THE PROPOSAL

1. The project rationale

Erasmus+ Program offers a range of opportunities for competences improvement of vocational students. Nevertheless, those opportunities seem to be underexplored in many countries and schools often pay consequent amounts of money for consultancies in order to develop Erasmus+ Mobility Projects.

Horizont ProConsult is an entity supporting excellence in education, specifically in the VET field, by the development of learning programs for work based learning practices for students from vocational schools. Together with other organizations actively involved in the VET sector, Horizont ProConsult prepares materials that help vocational schools to develop work based learning practices for their students abroad thanks to the opportunities offered by the Erasmus+ program.

Regardless of the already expertise offered several vocational institutes and educational institutions often request for guidelines and support in the development and implementation of international apprenticeships and work based learning practices for their students. However, the capacities of their actions remain limited because of lack of appropriate training of the human resources, limited time for preparation of proposals, as well difficulties in partner finding. Such professional guidance and counselling as well action plans are considered as highly necessary in different VET realities and a lack of such opportunities is declared.

According to the European Training foundation, current initiatives are targeting specific areas of interest for both the EU and the Western Balkans. These include strengthening the rule of law, reinforcing engagement on security and migration, enhancing support for socioeconomic development, increasing transport and energy connectivity, initiatives for a digital agenda and supporting reconciliation and good neighbourly relations. The co-operation with Turkey continues, following the policy dialogue with the Commission.

Despite good economic recovery in the region, the labour market situation remains challenging, with a slow pace of job creation and joblessness remaining high, in particular among young people and women. Educational policy which responds to the demands of inclusive economies in the region remains an important priority, as does cooperation between vocational education and training and the private sector.





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On the other hand, after observing the data of the stagnating youth unemployment tendency in Europe, as well given the COVID-19 situation, the project idea arises as urgent since a severe lack of vocational competences in accordance with the real needs of the labor market is being detected. Moreover, problems related to skills mismatch are also identified, therefore dual education and work based learning practices have to be urgently tackled as priorities in this project and generally in the European continent.

Therefore, the current partnership aims at offering expertise and innovation in terms of reinforcing the links between the VET system and labour market by providing a structured plan for capacity development of VET entities for operate quality work based learning practices. The project shall as well increase the capacities of VET providers especially in the fields of apprenticeship schemes management, quality assurance, innovation and internationalisation. Thus, it seeks to provoke a long term impact for securing a positive future for the young people living in the Western Balkan countries.

The project idea is to offer quality expertise in the field of VET for enabling educational entities and vocational schools to get regularly engaged their students in **apprenticeship schemes** and to be able to offer to **vocational learners the opportunity to undergo WBL practices at national level and abroad. The project will serve to bridge the** formal education and labor market sectors, contributing to the creation of long term multi-level cross-sectorial networking and cooperation.

The following project objectives have been specified in view of bringing positive solutions to the described situation:

- To build up competences of educational staff to develop and implement WBL practices nationally and internationally
- To create strategies that promote the work based learning activities for vocational learners as a complementary educational paths in order to boost employability of young people
- To foster cooperation exchange of knowledge and capacity development in the field of work based learning and international mobility in the VET field between the schools and private sector representatives in view of building up strategic settings for developing vocational education and work based learning
- To provide VET providers with guidance and tools for designing and implementing WBL schemes, so to stimulate learning other than formal educational means and especially through direct involvement in working practical assignments and activities
- To create conditions and support the development of cross-sectorial networking in the VET field between the different regions
- To encourage the development of a multilevel cross-sectorial system that concretely fosters learning
- To create links and reinforce synergies between formal and non formal educational sectors, as well as labour market, so as to set up a favouring environment for cross-sectorial cooperation in view of enhancing youth employability through Vocational education and training





The project will combine various activities including international exchange of expertise and best practices for staff members of VET schools as direct target groups. It will involve 8 partner institutions from 6 countries including representatives of Western Balkan area. By aggregating their expertise, knowledge and competencies, a powerful insight and constellation of resources will be procured, since the project will work on a trans-national issue, which needs to be addressed not only on national but also at PAN - European level.

As a result, the project is expected to contribute to the development of a wider knowledgebased societies as it will develop opportunities for future work solutions, thanks to the opportunities to be proposed. It will stimulate the better integration of VET learners in the labour market by the engagement in sustainable learning paths, etc.

The project will operate a steady multi-stakeholder partnership and will deliver added value at international level at three performance areas:

- Network building
- Fostering mutual learning between Western Balkan and EU VET representatives and harmonisation of the mutual cooperation between them
- Pooling international resources to provide for greater scope and outreach of the results achieved

Partners consider that the project results on a long run will achieve strong and visible positive impact. Sharing the knowledge will allow partners to translate the results into new models and guidelines appropriate for their local realities. The project will encourage cross-sectorial partnership and cooperation at international level, by linking experienced VET providers with VET schools and educational institutions, in view of operating quality improvements in the fields of VET.
