WIFI

Tuzla has a public WiFi in the city centre, but sometimes there may be issues with connection. However, in all cafes, bars and restaurants there is a free WiFi and you can access it by asking the waiters for the password.

PANNONIAN LAKES

During summer days, Tuzla becomes a very popular spot for refreshment and enjoying the vacation feeling in the city centre, because Tuzla has the only salt lakes in Europe. Three salt lakes and waterfalls along with beaches in downtown will offer you a unique summer experience. Bring your swimsuits and enjoy in free time. Entrance fee costs around 3 EUR per person.

TOURIST TRAIN

If you want to go sightseeing around the nucleus of the city, you can hop on the tourist train. During the ride, passengers are informed about famous sites of the city along with historical details and a rich tourist offer. Train works regularly every day except Mondays. The starting point of the train is Trg Slobode (The Square of Freedom – which is the largest square in B&H), and it departs every hour from 10 to 17. One ride costs 1 EUR per person.

FOOD, BARS AND RESTAURANTS

In the city centre, there are many different restaurants, fast foods and places to eat (Čaršijska česma, Sezam, Mozaik, MamaMia, City Steak House). Bosnia and Herzegovina is famous for its gastronomy and delicious food, so definitely do not skip to try tuzlanski ćevapi, burek, baklava, hurmašica and other traditional foods and sweets. The best ice cream is in Papi Gelato, and if you want to visit bars and pubs, try Caffè Sloboda, Kapija, Wintorius, Just Caffè Pub, Nardi Pub or any other local place that catches your eye. Many of them play live music in the summer nights.

TAXI

The easiest way to get around in Tuzla is by having a taxi drive. Taxi is the easiest and cheapest local transport (even cheaper than a bus). We suggest that you dial 1517, 1519, 1525, 1530 and call a taxi to your address. One drive costs cca. 3-4 EUR (max. 4 persons)

LOCAL CURRENCY

Local currency in Tuzla is KM (konvertibilna marka). 1 EUR = 1,95 KM. Money can be exchanged in any bank or exchange offices.
